

Mount Vernon Academy Student Honor Code

The purpose of the Honor Code is to enhance the educational experience of every student that attends Mount Vernon Academy.

1. Grooming

Approved school uniforms must be worn properly at all times. Students out of uniform will be sent home. The administration will determine if a uniform is being worn improperly. Hair for boys must be above the collar, with at least some ear and eyebrows showing. Mount Vernon gym clothes must be worn at all times at the rec. center. All footwear must have at least a heel strap. Visible tattoos are prohibited. Boys cannot wear earrings.

2. Attendance

Regular attendance is expected. Utah State law requires all students age 6 to 18 years old be enrolled and attend school regularly.

3. Electronic Media

Students are not allowed to have cell phones and electronic media devices on the campus. Suspensions will be given if students are found with or have these devices in their locker. School phones are always available. Computer lab rules apply to computer use.

4. Alcohol, Drugs, Tobacco

Utah law and MVA prohibit the use, possession, distribution, sale, or being under the influence of alcohol, controlled substances, or intoxicants by students. These activities are prohibited in school, on school grounds, within 100 feet of school grounds, at school-sponsored activities, or when students are being transported in school vehicles.

5. School Safety

A weapon of any kind, fighting, or any activity that places other students in danger is prohibited. Students cannot drive away from campus during lunch.

6. General Behavior

There will be no profane language, which includes taking the Lord's name in vain. There will be no disrespect towards fellow students, teachers, staff, or visitors at our school. Drinks and food are not allowed in the classroom, library, or other inappropriate areas.
